

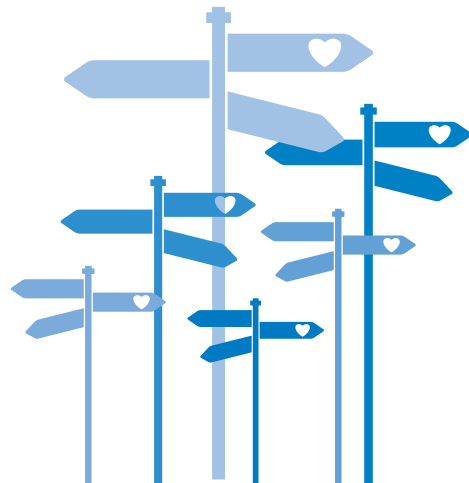

How to find us

The Phoenix Centre can be found next door to the Civic Centre.

By Road

From the East/Rochdale

Follow the A58 towards Heywood. On your approach into Heywood town centre, continue along the A58 (Rochdale Road East) and then bear left onto the Church Street (A6046) where you will find the Phoenix Centre located on the left hand side of the road.

From the West/Bury

Follow the A58 Bury New Road heading towards Heywood. If travelling on the M66, exit at Junction 2. On your approach into Heywood town centre, continue along the A58 onto Dawson Street and then following into Church Street (A6046) where you will find the Phoenix Centre located on the right hand side.

From the South/M62

Exit the M62 at Junction 19 and head north, following signs for Heywood on the A6046, Middleton Road. Continue on this road for approximately 2 miles and then take a left turn onto Church Street (A6046).

Continue along this road for approximately 250 yards when you will find the Phoenix Centre located on the left hand side of the road.

Parking

Disabled parking is available directly beside the practice and there is also a free public car park directly to the left of the centre at Civic Centre for all other patients.

Public transport

Trains: Castleton Railway Station is the closest station to The Phoenix Centre (approximately 12 minute taxi ride).

Bus Routes: The centre is on the route of the following buses 163, 164, 167, 461, 468, 471 and 475, which all stop outside Heywood Central Library.
